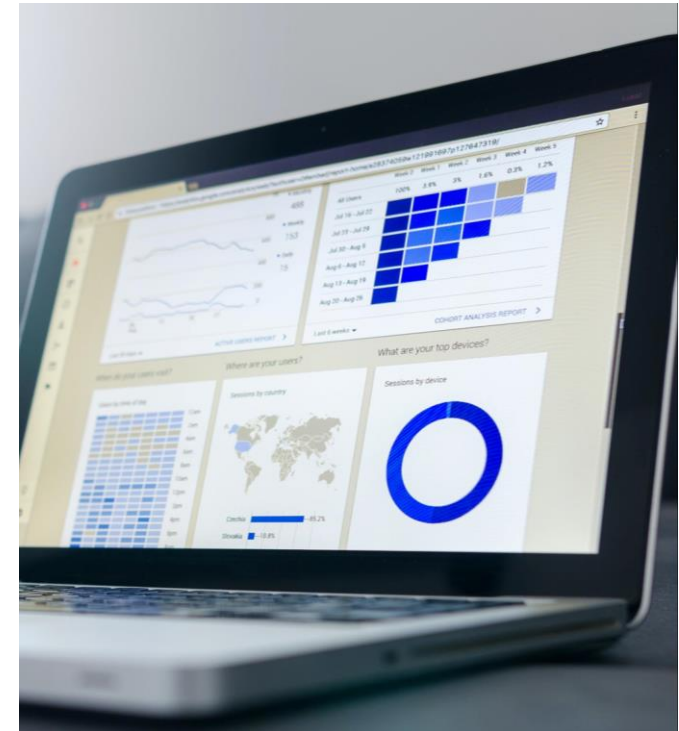

 - Important documents, reports, and tools



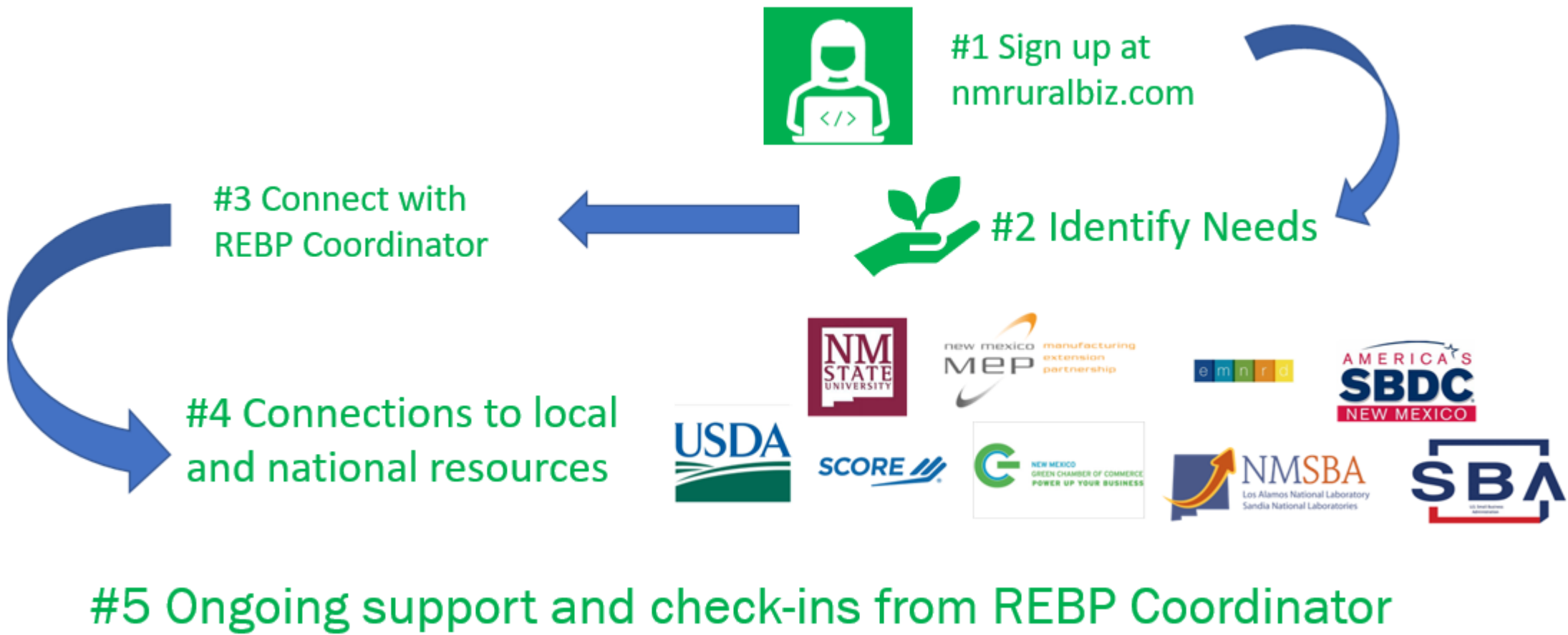
Rural Efficient Business Program
