“Manufacturing Month”

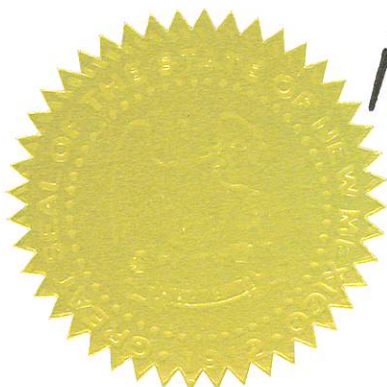
