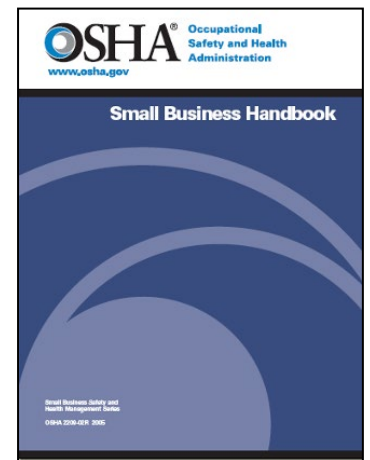


OSHA's Small Business Resources

On-Site Consultation Program. OSHA's On-Site Consultation Program offers free and confidential occupational safety and health services to small- and medium-sized businesses. On-Site Consultation services are separate from enforcement and do not result in penalties or citations. Consultants from state agencies or universities work with employers to identify workplace hazards, provide advice for compliance with OSHA standards, and assist in establishing and improving safety and health programs.
